Subject: Meeting with House Intelligence Committee

I have confirmed that we will be meeting with the House Intelligence Committee (Bill McFarland) this Wednesday at 9 am at their offices to review original Pike Committee records. The Committee is located in the Capitol (Room H 405). We will be bringing with us the 3 NARA boxes of open Pike Committee records in the JFK Collection (I have cleared this with Steve Tilley). I suggest we meet at the office at 8 am and then go over to the Capitol together. The purpose for our review is to identify the unredacted versions of those documents that have been redacted (without Board approval) and placed in the Collection. We would then get the Committee to give us copies of the unredacted versions, highlight the redactions, and ultimately have the Board pass on the redactions. As with the highlighted/redacted Church Committee materials, I would suggest that the FBI and CIA teams take responsibility for evaluating the postponements under the current standards and having them ultimately approved (as is or modified) by the Board. The volume of Pike Committee materials will be much less than the Church Committee materials.
