I told her that postponed records should be submitted no later than July1; that assassination records should be transferred to the JFK Collection no later than August 1; and that the Final Compliance Statement should be submitted no later than August 1. I asked that the postponed records be sent to us as soon as possible so they could be processed for voting by the Board. In addition, Ms. Pustay advised me that DOJ-Leadership is going to transfer its open records to the JFK Collection shortly.Don't forget to compose individual Action Item documents for any action items that resulted from the call!
