Subject: LBJ Library Visit

My trip to the Library went very well. Tina was very well organized and had the material available immediately.1. Oral histories-- I gave Tina the list of oral histories and she put in a request to the oral history person to check the status of each. She did not have this information available when I left but said she would call you.2. Stegall Files--They had already made copies of the files you and Jeremy had marked on your last trip. I went through these and marked them as assassination records. They were going to begin making RIF's immediately. The stack is 1 to 1 and 1/2 inches thick. Most of the documents are not classified (I think only 3 had classifications). They will probably be sent directly to Steve Tilley as open-in-full but you might want to check. The classified documents will be sent to us for review.3. I also reviewed a recently discovered box of the raw materials used by LBJ to write The Vantage Point "Dallas Chapter." I marked a number of these files (most in fact) as assassination records and they will be copied. None of these materials are classified so they will probably be sent directly to Tilley once the copies are made and the RIF's are completed.4. The Drew Pearson and William Westmoreland files have not been reviewed for assassination records.5. I also looked at some odds and ends such as Walt Rostow's appointment books--no assassination records were identified.Finally, I left some papers on your desk which Tina gave me. I hope you find them useful.
