In my report on edge print, I propose to state: "In our first meeting with the ARRB, 14 September 1996, we had the opportunity to visit the National Archives, College Park, MD, and make a very basic preliminary visual evaluation of the photographic evidence, film identification markings including the A. Zapruder movie film and a copy held by the NARA. The results of this evaluation were provided to Mr. James Milch, Director, Image Science Division, Research Laboratories in a Follow-up Report dated 19 December 1996. (Submitted to the ARRB by Mr. Milch in his letter of 7 January 1997.)" There is no question about the need to expand the analysis of edge print for the Zapruder film, its copies and the 35mm films. However, comments were made in my report to Milch regarding the sheet and x-ray films.
