**Body:** Dear Jack: Tomorrow the National Archives is opening the vault where the camera-original of the Zapruder film is housed to allow the national media to film the facility. This is being done so that the media will be able to shoot footage of the place where LMH did its work to make copies of the film. I am waiting to hear from Susan Cooper at the Archives to find out who from the media is expected to show up. Dan Rather is also running a story tonight about the film and the transfer of it to the JFK Collection. We did not receive any calls from CBS about that story. I have received a few phone calls this morning, particularly from CNN and ABC World News Tonight. Both are working on stories and have requested a possible interview with you to discuss the importance of the Zapruder film as an assassination record. Neither was sure if the interview would take place today or tomorrow. I will keep you posted on any developments. Eileen
