The report was not passed by the Parliament. Some thought that it had nothing to do with the Parliament and others said that it was not hard enough on "sects". Consequently, the Parliament voted to send it back to the Civil Liberties Committee for further consideration. There are really two main possibilities now. It will either get dropped because there is not enough time to deal with it before the next European elections in about 9 months time - or else it will have to be pushed through during this time period which is not seen as all that likely as there is a heavy schedule
