Belvoir. Dr. Finnegan, the INSCOM expert on ASA, had identified a unit history related to ARRB's request for documents detailing ASA surveillance activities in Mexico City. The purpose of the ARRB visit was to review this document.Michelle Combs and Jim Goslee each reviewed the document, which contained one small paragraph on surveillance activities in Mexico City. The paragraph did not provide anything substantive on information collected as it was part of a the unit history for a unit with detachments all over the world. This unit history was written as an attempt to summarize the world-wide collection activities of this ASA activity in the broadest and most general terms. It did, however, characterize collection efforts in Mexico City as largely ineffective due to technical difficulties.The unit history was not identified as an assassination record and will not be incorporated into the JFK collection at NARA.Don't forget to compose individual Action Item documents for any action items that came from the meeting!
