Here is the synopsis of the Board determinations for the two discussion issues presented by the Military Team at the August 6th Board Meeting:-Board voted 3-0 to approve staff "NBR" recommendations in staff memo dated August 5, 1998, that recommends 4 documents in the Army's IRR file on defector Vladimir Slovoda be designated "not believed relevant" to the assassination of President Kennedy.-Board voted 3-0 as follows on the Army's IRR file on Mitchell Livingston Werbell, III (in two separate motions):-To open in full 3 records that the Army had wanted postponed in full: 194-10006-10019; 10290; and 10292; and-To allow postponements ONLY for the following information in the remainder of the Werbell file: -Social Security Numbers; -Personal identifiers of Werbell's children (namely, addresses, DOB and POB); and-The names, job descriptions and other identifying data that would make public the identity of two U.S. government sources on [Screened by: NARA RD-F on October 24, 2016 according to the John F. Kennedy Records Collection Act of 1992, 44 U.S.C. 2107, Assassination Records Review Board, Guidelines for records not believed relevant (NBR)].
