Subject: Trip to IP

Bob and I are going out early to a meeting on the potential problem documents for the next Board meeting. I left directions for IP in your inbox. It takes at least 45 minutes to get there. I usually allow an hour because of potential traffic problems. The security briefing is at 3:30. The meeting is at 4:00 with Lee Strickland and Jim Oliver. On the requests, the CIA provided either a response or materials for review for all but four requests by our last Friday deadline. (Not all the materials have been reviewed yet but what Ben and I have seen look like thorough responses.) The four outstanding requests are all Directorate of Operations requests over which Barry has little control -except to nag. It would be worth mentioning to Lee Strickland that at a meeting on July 16, the DO promised all their responses by August 1. (Strickland was at the July 16 meeting and he can nag at a higher level.) The four requests are CIA-16 (accounting for all LHO pre-assassination files), CIA-IR-16 (the disposition of the files of former Chief of Counterintelligence James Angleton), CIA-IR-12 (CIA contacts with any journalists or publishing houses which produced post-assassination books), and CIA-IR-18 (information on a particular DO office)
