Furthermore, they reported to Mr. Haron that a female high-ranking Navy Pathologist (Chief of Infectious Diseases) claims (according to Moore) that she was told about the notes, but McAdams and Junkkarinen said they did not have her name or telephone number---that only Moore had her name. Attempts this date by staff member Doug Horne to contact Bill Moore proved fruitless; the number provided by General Counsel Ron Haron after his call with McAdams and Junkkarinen proved to be a disconnected number; the number of the only listing for "Bill Moore" in that same area code, 305, proved to be for a person who said he knew nothing about the Kennedy autopsy or any autopsy notes. Without Bill Moore to provide the identity of the Navy Pathologist , ARRB's only recourse was to contact Dr. Ken Dobson in Georgia. McAdams and Junkkarinen had told Haron that they had contacted Dobson on their own, and that he acknowledged finding an original typewritten autopsy report while at Bethesda, but not any notes.
