Subject: Dallas Depositions

Laura -- I raised with Jack the issues with respect to the Dallas depositions --i.e., doing a joint deposition and possibly videotaping it. Steve gave me Mr. Marshall's phone number, and we will need to have Jack call Mr. Marshall to explain the need to transport the autopsy photos (copies, not the originals) to Dallas since we cannot compel the doctors to come to Washington, D.C. I hope that Jack can persuade Mr. Marshall to grant permission. --Ron
