Another RIF should be made for the 4-page document dated 3/29/63 which is a "Staff Study Report US Military Alerting System." To further assist your locating it, the document is a DOD orig from JCS to CINCARIB and was previously exempted as NLK-75-197. Could you 1. Let me know if a new RIF was created2. If so, is it on the most recent diskette you sent to us?
