I've been mulling this over for the past week and I think I'd better give it to you now, before it's too late:In the Recommendations Section of our Final Report, I think we should include the following entry:"Congress should amend Section 6103 of the Internal Revenue Code to Provide for Release of All Tax Information Placed into the JFK Collection in the National Archives in response to specific requests of the Assassination Records Review Board. Tax information includes tax returns, earnings information, and other information gathered by IRS during the conduct of tax-related investigations."Most of the assassination records placed in the Archives by the IRS are either postponed in full, or postponed in part, and are identified by Record Identification Forms created in the summer of 1998, number series "137." The IRS submissions were in response to formal requests in an ARRB letter of March 12, 1998.
