Subject: Schlesinger
Stephanie Fawcett spoke with Arthur Schlesinger this morning to ask about the alleged missing RFK diaries (remember the Board asked about this when Stephanie gave her presentation.) His recollection (after 25 years) is that the so-called diary was really a scattered collection of memos and notes RFK wrote after key events, e.g.. Bay of Pigs, the Missile Crisis or isolated incidents. The papers were not in a chronological order. Since it wasn't a diary in book form, there is no real way of knowing if anything is missing. At the time that he first read the papers, Ethel Kennedy had them. at Hickory Hill. A few years later they were donated to the Library along with the rest of RFK's papers. Recently, library staff came across the types of memos as described by Schlesinger in the classified and confidential files. Stephanie mentioned this in the compliance letter. The JFK Library will process them and submit to donor committee. They will send anything relevant to the assassination to the JFK collection.
