When I first started Jeremy mentioned several areas of unanswered questions, including the question of what happened to the ORIGINAL tape recording (dictabelt) made by the Dallas police dispatcher (which I gather was transmitted by a motorcycle officer who left the microphone on his cycle turned on, thereby transmitting the sounds of the gun shots, etc.) My understanding from Jeremy was that the original tapes had disappeared/been lost and that it would be a real accomplishment to find it/them. I've since read the Findings and Recommendations of the HSCA at page 67. I understand the HSCA to say they submitted the original Dictabelt recordings made on 11/22/63 of transmissions over channel 1 to BBN in May 1978 for analysis. Is this the recording that is missing (ie. did BBN or the HSCA loose it) or did I misunderstand Jeremy? If any of this makes sense stop by when you get a chance. No rush. Thanks!
