I copied the serials from this file that were available at the FBI, which means only those serials that contain some postponements (although I copied the unredacted originals). As I recall, most of the serials shown on that file's inventory sheet contained no redactions, which means that the corresponding serials should be available to the public, in full and original form, at College Park.It follows, I think, that if you put together the serials I copied at the FBI with the serials with no postponements publicly available at College Park, you will have the complete FBI HQ file on the possible theft of JFK autopsy photos -- but why don't you show me the parts of the file you have now?
