Lawrence Schiller who claimed to have been commissioned by Life magazine to conduct inquiries regarding
Clay Shaw and his whereabouts and doings in San Francisco at the time of the assassination. Further, Schiller
was in touch with Garrison. Schiller sent Life a tape on which he dictated the findings of his investigation of
Shaw and the details of his discussion with Garrison. The recipient of the tape at Lifewas a Mr. Richard Bailey
in NYC. I don't know if this tape and/or possible accompanying report is the type of record you might be
interested in, or not. Or, this may be old news to you. In any case, FYI.
