Officer, too).Can you contact St. Louis for me and try to get information on his most recently known whereabouts? I think a phone interview may be in order, because I do not expect the servicerecords of other marines from this time period to reveal what TYPE of I.D. card they received, only its unique serial number, which tells the reader nothing.Here's what I have on DELGADO: DELGADO, Nelson Former USMC Service Number #1644884 Served at MACS-9 from 04 SEP 57-11 NOV 59, and was discharged from active duty in the Marine Corps on 25 NOV 59. He subsequently enlisted in the U.S. Army (went on active duty) on 01 NOV 1960.Thank you, in advance.
