1) Michelle Mrdeza -- when I type "Michelle" into my "To" field in the E-mail system, my computer makes me choose between Mrdeza and Seguin, but the default is to Mrdeza, for some reason, so if I click the "OK" button w/out thinking (as I did in this case) I end up listing Mrdeza in my "To" list. (Now, why Mrdeza is in there at all, I don't know.) I can choose to have it go to "our" Michelle instead of Mrdeza but simply made a mistake this time. Of course, if I send the E-mail with Mrdeza in the "To" field the computer then tells me I can't send it to her and do I want to send it everyone else I've listed in the field, etc.2) Many of the 16 that were listed as referred but actually present consisted of WC era documents that must have been subsequently cleared by NARA. In some cases, there was, in fact, a penciled-in "open" marking in the RIFs in our boxes, but we had decided we had to treat them as referred for purposes of this experiment.3) The withdrawn documents at NARA II for which there was no referral sheet from NARA's notebook were a mixed bag: the RIF for one indicated "referred", the others were blank in the status field.
