Anna: The staff had two objectives in going to the Records Center in St. Louis: (1) To develop personal-identifying data on individuals of interest as a first step in locating them. We are seeking to locate these individuals to determine whether they possess (or are aware of the existence of) assassination records. (2) To locate assassination records that can be found in personnel files. As you well know, personnel files are a rich resource for the researcher. They contain a wide range of types of records (performance evaluations, disciplinary actions, letters of commendation, etc.) that can reveal a great deal not only about individuals, but also about institutions and events. In fact, personnel files may be the only source for a record whose other copies have been destroyed. St. Louis may have extremely important (an undiscovered) records.
