After reviewing a Secret Service trip report from November 1963, I came across evidence of protective support rendered to the assigned Secret Service detail by local military units. This type of military support is inconsistent with our earlier findings. The report also notes the names of military personnel who participated in assisting the Secret Service. The names noted are as follows: Lt. Col. Ruffin W. Gray, Strike Command, McDill Air Force Base; Capt. Robert A. Moon, 836th Air Patrol Division; Capt. William T. Saxton, Strike Security Division; and Capt. Jack C. Overstreet, OSI McDill Air Force Base. I spoke with Tim, and we decided it would be worthwhile for you to try to locate these people. We may be interested in interviewing them with regard to the context of their work with the Secret Service in this instance and others.
