Tracy, I think this reflects a relatively recent change in FBI policy on who may receive an unescorted Official Visitor's badge. The recent change is that you have to have a Top Secret clearance to get the badge. (Previously, some of us on the FBI team received badges before the TS clearances were received.) So, I think this means that all you have to do is send to the FBI the paperwork on Ron's TS clearance (which I guess you'd be doing anyway), and once the FBI has the paperwork in hand, Carol can arrange for Ron to be photographed, etc. for the badge.
