Body: David and Kathy--I have reviewed Life magazine for November 29 and December 6, 1963, and I have found no mention of an autopsy. Bethesda is referred to as the place where Jackie requested that the body be taken for preparation for burial. I am still in search of the first published references to the autopsy and to the names of Boswell, Finck, and Humes.
