Dear Mr. Bailey, thank you for your e-mail message to me. I apologize for the delay in responding to you. As for your list of questions, I regret to inform you that we do not have the resources (time/staff) to answer all of these. We are a small, independent agency that was created to oversee the release of classified records pertaining to the assassination of President John F. Kennedy. Our purpose is to review records and to make them available to the public. We are dedicated (and mandated) to enhancing the historical record -- this is not a new investigation. I will suggest you read the official government reports (Warren Commission report, and the HSCA report) for background information. In addition, any library or bookstore has hundreds of books and articles about the assassination. I will mail to you the NYT Magazine article about June Oswald. Although you provided me with Sgt. Kemp's mailing address, I only have your e-mail address. Please send me your mailing address and I will put the article in the mail. I hope this information is helpful to you.  We also had several other questions, that I was hoping you might answer.
 1. Was J.D. Tippit's murder ever investigated beside to say that Oswald was the shooter? Was Tippit's background investigated to check for links to anyone else involved in the case? Did Tippit have any radio communication with the police station immediately prior to his death?
 2. Are there any copies of FBI telex that warned of Kennedy's assassination left undestroyed. Did any of the offices keep it despite their orders to destroy it?
 3. Did anyone ever trace the ambulance or the driver of the ambulance that took the epileptic from Deally Plaza?
 4. Where was Oswald buried?
 5. Does the review board have the ability to exhume Gov. Connally's body to check the fragments in his wrist and compare them to the magic bullet?
 6. Did LBJ ever testify about the possible involvement of the government in the assassination or the cover-up?
 7. What was the official reasoning for putting the media vehicle so far behind the president's convertible?

 9. Who has Jackie's diary? Does the board have the ability to subpoena her diary?
