I have original AP wire copy from Nov 22, 23, and 24th, 1963. In all there are 188 "pages" of copy from the Radio/TV "broadcast" wire of the AP, including Texas "splits" (the wire copy came from a Dallasradio station) from shortly before the assassination up to and including the Oswald assassination. I plan to sell the original AP copy through a New York auction house. This is the actual AP copy that broadcasters read to the nation as the minute-by-minute details of the assassination became known, including erroneous reports (a secret service agent was also shot; Johnson may have had a heart attack). I'm willing to sell photocopies of the original wire copy to JFK buffs. Please email me at wharrison@hcds.net for more info.
