I have to admit at that point that I was not too familiar with much of the material that he brought back with him from Miami. However, after reading the LaFontaine book, he seems to be building on some of their research into DRE activities. I agree with him that the records would be significant, especially if we could get records related to the New Orleans and Dallas chapters of the DRE, among other items. When I last spoke to the people at the U of Miami, they told me that the DRE records were open to the public (provided they obtained a pass to their archives), and that they would not be indexed or logged in, which would obviously make examining the collection for significant records difficult. It was my impression that Jeremy did not feel that it was worth it for us to go to Miami, given that the records were already open. However, without having done an examination of the collection, it is hard to say if the records donated to the U of Miami would give us any leads on additional records to be obtained. It is also my impression that we have tried to contact Salvat, to talk to him about a number of different things, but to no avail (he did not respond to Jeremy's phone calls or letters, as far as I know).
