Subject: Nagell News Release

Thom:I have attached (I hope) my edits of the Nagell release. Let me know if it didn't work and I'll send it another way.A few comments:Consistent with past practice, I put "News Release" on top as opposed to "Press Release."I have single spaced because with my edits I couldn't keep it on two pages, which I always find to be important. (I know you like the double spaced format.)Consistent with past practice and general Review Board practices, I did not indent the paragraphs.I changed the characterization of Nagell in the first paragraph, so we are not characterizing him ("shadowy"), simply stating what he was (former Army intelligence officer).I stuck in a quote from Jack. I thought we needed one. I know your thoughts on canned quotes. When we get close to the date of release, you could run it by Jack (as well as David, of course).I redrafted paragraph describing the documents. I cut out some of the documents that are further removed from the date of the assassination (1969 and 1979). I put the sentence describing what is in two of the documents at the end of that paragraph, but not having seen the actual documents, I don't know if both documents show that he said he knew nothing about the assassination or if it is just the Secret Service report on the El Paso interview.I took out the reference to the FBI and Secret Service investigations because that would be challenged by researchers and I thought we could avoid that quagmire.I put in two standard paragraphs about: (1) copies of selected documents being available from the Review Board and (2) the originals going to the Archives.Susan Cooper should be contacted and advised of upcoming release of the files. I would consult with Steve as well, just to cover all of the bases. Susan and Steve need to be coordinated with on whatever date is arrived at for the release.
