However, we have had some success in obtaining records from the New Orleans Metropolitan Crime Commission and from former New Orleans District Attorney Jim Garrison's investigative files. We continue to pursue other local records and hope to make them available to the public as part of the JFK Assassination Records Collection at the National Archives and Records Administration, located at College Park, Maryland.
