HorneSummary of the Call:Responding to my request for ONI Command Histories, Mr. Walker, after searching the Navy Historical Center Archives, responded by saying that he could find no ONI Command Histories from 1957-1964. He said this indicated that they either were not written, or were not received by his center. I asked him if he had any records of the activities of Naval Attaches in Moscow from 1957-1964, and he said "not that he was aware of, per se, no." However, he did say that there were some sporadic copies of a publication called "ONI Reviews" in their archives--he could not recall what years. He said the publication was originally classified, and was for dissemination within DOD only. He could not remember, off-hand, specific examples of what was in the "ONI Reviews." He did volunteer that nothing on Moscow Naval Attache activity was likely to be in Command Histories, even if they did have any for those years. He said that Command Histories for Navy Commands generally contain administrative, and not operational, information (such as cost figures, numbers of employees, organizational and mission-statement type information). I told him that I was unsure whether I
