	not published in the FRUS Volume. We did not resolve how such documents would be accounted forOn the
	subject of INR, Ms. Noring indicated that they had done their own search for Kennedy assassination records
	and that "they had files labeled Kennedy asassassination." I presume these records were made part of the JFK
	Collection at NARA and, indeed, certain materials have emanated from INR. However, we may want to revisit
