NSA Summary of the Call: I called our poc at NSA at 1539, 04 Sept 97 to discuss two issues related to data disk  
information for NSA documents: 1. I informed her that we were in receipt of the most recent shipment of 63  
NSA documents, however, the data disk that they sent us is incompatible with the drives on our classified  
computers. (None of our classified computers possesses a 5.25" drive.) She expressed a little frustration and  
informed me that all of the disks that the NSA has sent before were of the 5.25" variety. She then asked me  
how we were able to process the earlier disks, since all of them were classified and all of them were 5.25"  
disks. I told her that I had only recently taken over this project and was unaware of how the previous data was  
handled. She then told me that she would look into the possibility that her people could create an unclassified  
disk with the relevant RIF info for the 63 documents that was compatible with our drives. She told me that she  
would get back to me when she had an answer. 2. I asked her about RIF data disks for the four NSA  
documents that were shipped in March 1997 that were part of an earlier batch of 49. 32 of these documents  
were opened in full and officially declassified by NSA, and 13 of the remaining 17 contained "green" redactions  
which were voted on by the Board in March 1997. ARRB lacked the required RIF information for four (4) of  
these documents, and was therefore unable to officially vote on them (see #s below). Our poc informed me  
that she would look into the matter and hopefully send the data on the disk which contained the RIF info for  
the 63 documents referenced above. RIF information lacking, shipment of 49, delivered March, 1997 144-
