Categories: are that, during the second and third weeks in October, for a variety of reasons, only the following three days
are O.K. for scheduling of the depositons: Thursday, October 16th Tuesday, October 21st Thursday, October
23rd Because of the difficulty of getting a stranger from National Airport to College Park,, I most strongly
recommend that we do these on separate days. These men should be met at the airport by me, and escorted
to College Park. Doing so will pay dividends, especially in this case, and not doing so may make the difference
between a fully cooperative witness, and one who is irritated by the time the deposition starts. (This approach
paid off handsomely with Sibert and O'Neill.) I do not want to schedule these for the last week in October if we
can avoid it because of the possibility of doings in a city up north that week.
