Waldron had suggested in his October 15 e-mail to you that the Review Board may not be releasing Cuba-related military records. Ironically, on October 14, the Board acted to release numerous Cuba-related military records the existence of which previously was not known -- including some very interesting highly classified records from late 1963. It took us about six months to get them through the military bureaucracy and to the Board. It sure is easy to criticize from afar . . . . They will become available to the public within a month or so. Thanks for the Waldron info and the Custer tapes and records.
