called today to advise us that the NARA staff had identified approximately two boxes of materials from the
Senate Internal Security Committee (the Eastland Committee) that they believe are assassination-related.
Some of the material includes testimony (including testimony of Ruth Paine). According to Ms. Wilhelm, the
material is still classified but counsel for the Senate Judiciary, which has jurisdiction over the records, has
authorized release for the purpose of obtaining declassification by the relevant agencies. Accordingly, Ms.
Wilhelm will have the material copied and will call us next week for us to pick it up. We should then review it
to confirm that it is assassination related under the Act and then refer it to the appropriate agencies for
declassification. Don't forget to compose individual Action Item documents for any action items that resulted
from the call!
