Usually a researcher has asked for a document which the database says is open, and the copy in Steve's version is incomplete. When this happens I just make a copy and send it with whoever is going next. I never document these transactions because it never seemed necessary. Today, Steve called with a question about numbered file 013783 (180-10105-10059). In this case, the document was previously referred, was published as a consent release in the notice for the October 16, 1996 meeting (published 11/5/96). Steve had only one page (of thirty-six pages) of the document in his version, but it had a Final Determination Form attached to it. Our original copy does not have a Final Determination Form attached to it, and so in our box, the document looks like it is still referred. But the database version of our rif indicates, in the lookup field, that it was published as a consent release last fall. Will you look for this document on your lists? I guess we can both look at it together when you get here. From now on, I guess I will e-mail you whenever something like this
