The Department of the Navy and the Department of the Air Force have submitted their Final Declarations of Compliance under the JFK Act. Please note, however, that the Office of Naval Intelligence ("ONI") will be submitting a separate, final compliance report.2. We have received a DRAFT of the CIA's initial Statement of Compliance, although you may not want to mention this in view of the fact that we only have an unofficial draft.3. The Civil Division, Federal Programs Branch, has agreed to make available certain FOIA litigation files that relate to FOIA requests for Kennedy assassination materials. 4. We have reviewed and have proposed designation of certain records, as assassination records, from the Records Management Office of the Executive Office of the President. 5. We have requested that the Criminal Division make available any internal security records relating to Oswald and certain individuals who had contact with Oswald when he returned to the United States. We have also requested any records the Criminal Division might have on the Garrison case.6. We have requested the Criminal Division to designate, as an assassination record, its file on Arthur Balletti. This relates to the CIA's use of Giancana in connection with anti-Castro operations.7. The Library of Congress was requested to submit a statement, by today, regarding its compliance with the JFK Act. I have not seen anything come in as of yet. 8. We are still working with the Senate Intelligence Committee and the Clerk of the House to identify assassination records among certain Congressional holdings.
