I believe -- but am not 100 percent certain -- that the RIFs were made by the House Committee staff. Presumably, the computerized information was then transmitted to NARA/Tilley when the Pike Committee documents were transmitted to the JFK Collection. I think for purposes of our review of original Pike Committee records, we do not need a member of Steve's staff. At the House Intelligence Committee, what we would be doing is essentially matching up the unredacted documents with their redacted versions in the JFK Collection. We can then copy the appropriate RIF and attach it to the unredacted document, take it back to our office, highlight the redacted information for Board consideration, and then deal with updating the RIFs at that point (I would probably ask Steve's staff to do it).
