Just so you all don't think that I am making wild suggestions, off the top of my head, to request things that are already in the archives, I want to explain that I had raised the New Orleans FPCC issue because I had reviewed the FBI Compliance Statement and the JFK Collection Register, and neither had identified a New Orleans file for the FPCC (only the HQ FPCC file was identified as an HSCA subject). After I got your message, I went back to doublecheck. Both the Compliance Statement and the Register do list New Orleans file 97-74, but it is identified as a "JFK Assassination Investigative File," which I had assumed was an investigative file opened up after the assassination.
