Initially he thought it was a good idea but after speaking with a couple of the library archivists, problems with this arrangement arose. For example, the LBJ Library had concerns about possible deed of gift issues governing the release of records. In addition, the libraries would need to have their own data bases updated anyway. They were, however, very appreciative of our offer. The plan now is that after we inform the Libraries on the status of reviewed documents, they will update the RIFs, attach them to the documents and send new copies to Steve at NARA. We will process the sanitized documents, make copies for the Libraries as they have the originals, and they will prepare RIFs reflecting the current status and forward them to NARA. Unfortunately, perhaps the extra copying involved might mean a few too many trees will have died in vain.
