Subject: Back in the USSR
There is some confusion about which documents were transferred from Russian and when. As best I can piece together the story, it goes something like this:1. After receiving a cable from State in 1995, the Russians transmitted 17 pages to the State Department in November 1995. Those records were lost by State. In November 1996 the Russians gave State another set of these documents, which were then transmitted to the Review Board. The State Department arranged for translations of these documents and they sent the translations to us. All of these records are in our files.2. According to your letter to Kennedy, and by David's rough recollection as of this morning, Lebedev gave you, David, and Kermit a set of seven pages when you visited with him in Moscow in 1996. These records are not in our files. Do you have a copy of them? Do you know where they are? Are they a subset of the seventeen pages? When I spoke to David this morning, he was unsure about these records but said as far as he knows they would be in our files. They aren't. If you have any illumination on this, it would be of help. Thanks,Jeremy
