Maura Pierce of C-SPAN called. She has been working on programs that deal with the recently released LBJ tapes. She wanted to check in on Board activities, with the possibility that a Board member could appear on C-SPAN's morning show, Washington Journal. The idea (preliminary) would be to discuss where the Board is in the declassification process, when we shut down, etc. I told her that the Board is having a regular closed meeting on the 13th, and that there will be an experts conference on declassification on the 14th. She is not sure of any interest, but asked if there would be objections to having cameras present at the experts conference. I told that I did not know but that I would check. I spoke with Anna immediately after this call, and in response to Anna's asking if there has been any media interest, I told her about my phone call with Maura Pierce. Anna said that she thinks the experts, particularly from the agencies, may be inhibited by the presence of cameras. At any rate, Ms. Pierce would like a Board member to appear on Washington Journal. She is gathering information to pitch the idea to her supervisors.
