She believes that all the non-RFK EHUs are open but if we want them sent to the collection they would need to be RIF'd. She seemed quite willing to accommodate us but that we'd have to make the call. Since those records were designated as EHUs at an earlier period in Review Board history, I wonder if they wouldn't qualify as ARs by today's standards. The bottom line is they are open at JFKL but if we want them at NARA we need to declare them AR's. Priscilla McMillan: Tom did not actually make contact with her but he and Megan discussed the plan for the Library to make copies, one box at a time, return the originals to her if she was willing. The Library is waiting for us to take some sort of action on this. Tom thought Megan would have more influence, but she thinks the impetus should come from the Board otherwise Priscilla would be suspicious of the Library. (Apparently she can be quite prickly) Again Megan seemed quite accommodating. LBJ Library is not completely off the hook yet. I have discovered a number of Postponed in Full records in the database that don't correspond with the universe I thought we had to worry about. They are looking into it. Part of the problem could simply be the database was never updated to reflect changes in status. But the bad news is that some records have never been referred, even under mandatory review. Meanwhile I had thought along, because this is what they told us, that the only outstanding issues were the MR cases. One of the items listed as postponed in full is tapes and transcripts of McCone conversations.
