Carrie -- When you have an opportunity, could you review your notes on FBI-29 and double check a serial number for me? In your memo, you recommended that we designate three records as assassination records, but I think that one of the serial numbers is missing a number. You wrote: 105-807875 Section 12 May 1961 through April 1961; Serial Scope 353-3762355, -362 and -1nr 36 John Edgar Hoover correspondence from May 2, 8, and 9th 1961 (declassified under JFK act on 3-30-95). I think that the "36" that follows "-1nr 36" must be missing a number. Do your notes help to clarify? Let me know. Thanks. Laura
