Tab is what you're supposed to use on paragraphs. On block quotes, you should use double indent (Ctrl+Shift+F7), which indents on both the left and the right. Either your indent icon was doing a double indent, or it was a hard tab, which indents the entire paragraph along the left margin. As far as 1st page suppress goes, I believe that refers to the fact that page numbers shouldn't appear on the first page of a chapter. I set up the template to do it this way, but let me know if something goes awry.
