Subject: NBR MEMO
Per our meeting this morning, the following is a summary of the two categories of NBR material in the SLOVODA file. 1. PFC Joseph T. White. White defected from the US Army across the DMZ into N. Korea. Although I have not been able to ascertain from the file the exact date of White's defection, the records indicate that he defected in early September 1982. There is no discernible relation between White and Slovoda. The following three documents have been postponed in full: 194-10001-10417: Army record of White family's request to view video tape of PFC White's press conference in N. Korea. 194-10001-10323: FBIS report of White's statement at his press conference in N. Korea. 194-10001-10421: Army summary of the known facts regarding White's defection across the DMZ. 2. Deserters from USS Intrepid in 1967. One DOD document, 194-10001-10415, from December 1967 regarding deserters from USS Intrepid has been postponed in full. It reports that during a surveillance operation Japanese police photographed two people who were believed to be US Army personnel standing near the Soviet ship Baikal. This document does not appear to be related to Slovoda. It is my recommendation that these documents be treated as NBR.
