This should give you most of what you were suggesting in your email. However, we stopped tracking the type of postponements when we started using Fast Track, so I'd only be able to give you info on the nature of the redactions for the older documents, which will probably not be a sufficiently random sample. I set up a few views in Review Track Archive that I thought might be useful for the final report under View | Final Report. You might want to check them out to see if they provide useful information, if there's anything else you'd like to see in them, etc. Also, let me know if you have questions about just what you're looking at in a given view; I've even forgotten what's in some of them and will have to look at their selection formulas to remind myself.
