


## THE BLACK VAULT



SUBJECT : Overseas Testing and Application of

Behavioral Drugs

- 1. Reference is made to the verbal request by Mr. If Staff, to the Acting Director of Security for transmittal of an Office of Security memorandum dated 15 September 1975 pertaining to subject.
- 2. A copy of the referent Office of Security memorandum dated 15 September 1975 is attached. As will be noted from a review of the attached memorandum, available file information reflected references to only a few specific instances where drugs were utilized overseas. It is clear, however, that the few cases mentioned specifically do not constitute a full itemization of all cases conducted overseas.
- Agency components such as the Office of Medical Services and the Office of Technical Services may have more detailed information pertaining to subject. Office of Security files reflected little involvement in the utilization of drugs overseas by the Office of Security after the early 1950's.
