NON-LETHAL PERSONNEL BEHAVIORAL CONTROL

General Considerations:

- 1. Possible contract for a year or more but may be supported by increments.
- 2. In essence, the effort would be primarily concerned with providing biological-psychological scientific advice and guidance to support behavioral control systems being fabricated and tested by other concerns and/or to recommend the development or abandonment of plans to undertake R&D concerned with potential behavioral control systems.
 - 3. The above may include, but not be limited to:
- (a) Evaluation of status and progress of on-going projects. For instance, (a) the use of high intensity light, with minimum risk of permanent retinal damage, as a behavioral control system, and (b) use of leither in isolation or in combination with for temporary individual restraint, the system being activated from a distance.
- (b) Evaluation of currently available literature, and research projects underway to determine the feasibility of developing a _____/that would meet the incapacitation requirements.
- (c) To conduct scientific "armchair" evaluations of potential incapacitation systems, i.e., electrical current, etc.
- (d) To undertake supporting laboratory studies as appropriate.
