

SUBJECT: Disposition of ITEK (-9) Mapping Cameras

The subject cameras which were intended for use in the LMSS program (UPWARD) have been declared surplus at Manned Spacecraft Center, Houston, Texas and available at Surplus Sales at MSC. The provisions of BYE 12726/68, 7 March 1968, have been reviewed. No documentation or reference to camera origin relating to NRO programs is with the hardware. They are simply surplus lunar mapping cameras from the terminated LMSS program.
