Dear Mr. Greenewald:

This responds to your request of 03 January 2017 to the National Reconnaissance Office to have "Document 200900179-03-003-008 – SIGINT and IBS 2014 Briefing for U.S. Northern Command, date created: 3/28/2005", reviewed for declassification.

Although your request was submitted to the National Reconnaissance Office (NRO), the NRO was not the originator of the document. The document was originated by the National Security Agency/Central Security Service (NSA). Accordingly, the NRO directed your request to NSA.

Therefore, NSA reviewed under the Mandatory Declassification Review (MDR) requirements of Executive Order (E.O.) 13526 and is enclosed. We have determined that some of the information in the material requires protection.

Some portions redacted from the document were found to be currently and properly classified in accordance with E.O. 13526. The information denied meets the criteria for classification as set forth in Section 1.4 subparagraph (c) and remains classified SECRET.

Additionally, Section 3.5 (c) of E.O. 13526, allows for the protection afforded to information under the provisions of law. Therefore, the names of NSA employees and information that would reveal NSA functions and activities have been protected in accordance with Section 6, Public Law 86-36 (50 U.S. Code 3605, formerly 50 U.S. Code 402 note).

Since your request for declassification has been partially denied you are hereby advised of this Agency's appeal procedures. Any person denied access to information may file an appeal to the NSA MDR Appeal Authority. The appeal must be postmarked no later than 60 calendar days after the date of the denial letter. The appeal shall be in writing addressed to the NSA MDR Appeal Authority (P133),

National Security Agency, 9800 Savage Road, STE 6881, Fort George G. Meade, MD 20755-6881.

The appeal shall reference the initial denial of access and shall contain, in sufficient detail and particularity, the grounds upon which the requester believes the release of information is required. The NSA MDR Appeal Authority will endeavor to respond to the appeal within 60 working days after receipt of the appeal.












PL 86-36/50 USC 3605 Input to IBS-Simplex Determined by the broadcast ordering scheme (BOS) for each IBS-S channel.












